Role: Beading Operative

Overview

Purpose of Position

To be part of the beading department team. This role plays an important part within the factory process and contributes to the end finish of parts as requested by a customer. There is an art to achieving the correct finish on parts. You must be able to read the job card that corresponds with the parts you are working on and be able to understand what finish has been requested by the customer. You will also be required to mask off some of the parts, normally using nylon screws, prior to beading in order to achieve the correct finish.

Key Skills and Qualities Required

- Be able to communicate with your supervisor and fellow operatives.
- Ability to ask questions of your supervisor if you are not sure or have any concerns about a job.
- Ability to work to the tight timescales as set by the packing supervisor.
- Ability to think under pressure and retain information.
 - Be able to work safely and efficiently.
 - Have a keen eye for detail and perfection.

Experience

- Previous experience working in anodising, metal finishing or engineering is preferred but not crucial.
 - Experience of working in a Production / Manufacturing environment preferred, but not essential.

Specific Responsibilities

- To be aware of the Health and Safety requirements within this environment and ensure that you adhere to them at all times.
- Ensuring high standards of hygiene and housekeeping are maintained, everything in its place
- Take direction from the beading supervisor about your work flow and be able to plan your time.
- Ensure you take part in all training activities and exercises in order to increase your working knowledge.
- Understand how to set up and clean your allocated beading cabinet.
- Maintain the high levels of quality Alpha is renowned for.
- Ensure you follow all ISO (quality standard) procedures.
- Be able to mask certain parts prior to beading.
- Understand what is classed as an acceptable and unacceptable finish.
