Role: Wet Floor Operative

Purpose of Position

To be part of the team on the anodising wet floor. This role includes learning the basic anodising process and being able to process jigs of work to the instructions contained on the corresponding job card. Your work flow will be set by the wet floor supervisor. You will need to assist with the tank maintenance as and when required.

Key Skills and Qualities Required

- Be able to communicate with your supervisor and fellow operatives.
- Ability to ask questions of your supervisor if you are not sure or have any concerns about a job.
- Ability to work to the tight timescales as set by the wet floor supervisor.
- Ability to think under pressure and retain information.
 - Be able to work safely and efficiently within this high risk environment.

Experience

- Previous experience working in anodising, metal finishing or engineering is preferred but not crucial.
 - Experience of working in a Production / Manufacturing environment

Specific Responsibilities

- To be aware of the Health and Safety requirements within this environment and ensure that you adhere to them at all times.
- Ensuring high standards of hygiene and housekeeping are maintained, everything in its place – it is especially important to ensure that all gangways and walkways are kept free and clear at all times.
- Take direction from the wet floor supervisor about your work flow and be able to plan your time.
- Ensure you take part in all training activities and exercises in order to increase your working knowledge of the wet floor and its safe operation.
- Understand how to safely place work into and out of the tanks and to follow the instructions on a job card.
- Maintain the high levels of quality Alpha is renowned for.
- Ensure you follow all ISO (quality standard) procedures – which includes signing off all job cards as required for your department and ensuring all cards are kept with the correct job to ensure traceability of work.
- Be able to assist the wet floor supervisor with basic tank maintenance.
